"We are all learners" - 19 European University representatives met in Bergen



The conference Spreading innovative results from European University Alliances to other higher education institutions, organized by four national agencies, Tempus Public Foundation, OeAD, DAAD, and the Norwegian Directorate for Higher Education and Skills, took place in Bergen from 3 to 5 May 2023. The **140 participants**, representing the European University Alliances, national agencies, higher education institutions, national authorities, and the European Commission, had the opportunity to **participate in plenary presentations, workshops**, and a variety of **networking** activities. After the usual online meetings during the pandemic, face-to-face meetings have become more valuable and highlighted the importance of networking alongside professional development. The Bergen program combined reports, roundtables, and personal exchanges from a variety of perspectives in a sensitive way, creating a forum for learning from each other.

Open University: Placebo: faking or making?

➔ The fourth part of the **Open University EUGLOH course**, organised by the University of Szeged, was completed in the spring semester of 2023. The online course, consisting of **12 lectures and a question-and-answer session**, was attended by more than **550 students** from the universities of the association.

➔ Our series of lectures focused on the notion of **placebo**. In addition to exploring the meanings of the term in medicine, we will take stock of the various aspects and layers of the term's extensive web of meanings. The meanings and associations connected with the term are highly controversial, and the process of interpretation is therefore promising. On the one hand, there are the meanings of absence, deception, false illusion, and on the other, the creative power of imagination, the scientifically measurable effects of caring attention, and the ritual aspects of any healing process.

➔ The topics of the lectures covered a **broad interdisciplinary spectrum**, from drama therapy to literary theory of the simulacrum, from changing fashions in management to the specific scientific understanding of early modern alchemists or the controversies around the Eucharist in 17th-century religious debates. Hopefully, the intersections of these themes not only shed light on the overlaps between disciplines, but also help us to rethink these boundaries and reflect on our assumptions related to the connections between healing, beliefs, and the imagination.

Joint Innovation Challenge - organized by USZ - ended with a success!

The course was a 9-week co-creation with international and multidisciplinary teams along with the facilitation of Demola Global. The course aimed to teach about alternative research approaches as well as monetizing on a real-world problem. The program ended with a pitching day where students presented their innovative business ideas that could tackle their challenge. Students closely worked with other students from different EUGLOH universities along with professional facilitation by Demola Global. The last week took place in Szeged, let's see what students experienced!

"It was an amazing experience that helped me explore different topics with which I was not familiar. It was quite enriching, not only on a professional but also on a personal level." - participating student testimony.



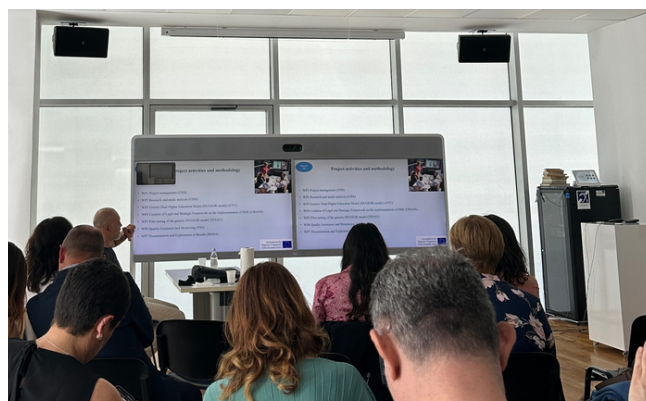
Previous Event Highlights

EUGLOH Workshop - Skills for Future Researchers, Porto, 17-19 May 2023

➔ This course intended to equip master and PhD students with transversal and necessary skills that will aid them in their path to become researchers. The course provided:

- Insights on the responsibility of scientists and researchers and their role in society;
- Specific tools and strategies that allow participating students to publish articles more successfully, given the increasing pressure to publish, either for knowledge, for academic or funding purposes;
- The necessary skills to transform complex concepts within the field of science into communication products that can be understood, adopted, and maintained by the community;
- Information regarding knowledge transfer of developed work and intellectual property.

➔ From the University of Szeged five young scholars attended the workshop.



Novi Sad BIP on Internationalization of Higher Education, 29 May - 2 June 2023

The University of Novi Sad is currently having a BIP Program for its partner universities, where they place internationalization of higher education in the focus. There are several colleagues from the University of Szeged, who take part in the Blended Intensive Program this week in Novi Sad.

There is a wide array of teachers and researchers having discussions on **Erasmus+ partnerships**, strategic alliances and ideas for the future of teaching, learning and projects.

Topics and presentations range from "**Internalisation in Education and Science**", "**Myths and facts about multilingualism**", or "**EdTech talents**".

From the University of Szeged, among others, colleges from the International Directorate, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences and the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration have delegated colleagues to the program.
