Kick off event, Munich

Renewed collaboration

The European University Alliance for Global Health has entered its second phase with the official kick-off event of EUGLOH 2.0 in Munich at the end of January. The event laid the foundation for the second round of joint efforts to establish a "European Education Area". Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München welcomed more than 150 committed participants from EUGLOH's eight other university partners: Université Paris-Saclay, University of Porto, University of Alcalá, University of Szeged, Lund University, Universität Hamburg, UiT-The Arctic University of Norway and the University of Novi Sad.

Working hard and overcoming demanding challenges while having fun, getting inspired and having time to breathe and smile. It might sound impossible, but it really isn't. The EUGLOH team at the University of Porto, led by Professor Tiago Gama Rocha, provided a visionary and inspiring staff training where the participants were working in teams to solve five EUGLOH-related issues – all of them revolving around communication (e.g.: how to involve more students, how to make onboarding around the Alliance easier, or how to make everyone feel as part of a team). They dug deeper and came up with some exciting ways to tackle the problems. They presented their progress every day, aligning the solutions and presentations according to the feedback from the mentors. A tough program – still a motivating one, after which all team members got to know each other better, realized we face the same obstacles, and got even more motivated to improve the alliance as we are all in this together. Date: 17 Mar 2023 – 19 May 2023


Online and last week in Szeged

Target Group: Students (BA/BSc, MA/MSc, PhD)

Host: University of Szeged

The course is a 9-week co-creation with international and multidisciplinary teams along with the facilitation of [Demola Global](#). The course aims to teach about alternative research approaches as well as monetizing on a real-world problem. You will work on real-life challenges, such as the future of healthcare, under-the-skin solutions, mental health, etc. You will explore the present of the given phenomenon, what the state-of-the-art is in the field, what kind of global trends has effect on them and in what way, and how it will possibly change in the future based on what we can see now. The final product of the program is a concept document that includes the team's findings and their envisioned future of their phenomenon. In addition to the concept document, the program will end with a pitching day where students will present their innovative business idea that can tackle their challenge.

You will closely work with other students from different EUGLOH universities along with professional facilitation by Demola Global. The last week will take place in Szeged, travelling and living expenses are covered by the EUGLOH Alliance.



4th International Symposium of Young Researchers on Medicinal Plants and Natural Product Research

Date: 22 May 2023 – 24 May 2023

Target Group: PhD Students, Researchers

Host: University of Szeged

The symposium aims to serve as a forum for discussions on trends, most current topics and latest results of medicinal plants and natural product research, and bringing together young scientists and PhD students from EUGLOH partner universities. This event will provide opportunity for discussion, knowledge sharing, and exchange of research ideas for students, academics, and researchers. Keynote and short lectures are welcome on the symposium. PhD students present their scientific results in form of short lecture (15 min), and they participate in the scientific program and discussion. Keynote lectures (30 min) will be presented by academics and researchers. Participants will present their work on site or online.
