Student Roadtrip to Hamburg!

17-22 November 2023 - Hamburg

The Alliance-level Student Boards are also meeting in Hamburg this month! 💪

Would you like to get a first-hand insight into the road trip? Read what our USZ SB member Réka Hegedűs and Florabelle Cabarrubias experienced so far! 📌

“The main goal of the Road Trip was to meet student board members from other universities and harmonize our work and best practices. For this purpose, we had a session every day when each LSB representative could share their board's best practices and the difficulties they faced. These discussions turned out to be extremely useful, as we were able to look at EUGLOH's work and the capabilities of the student boards from new perspectives.

In addition to these student board discussions, the student board members from Hamburg organized many activities in the afternoons. We were fortunate to visit several of the most famous places in Hamburg, such as the City of Warehouses (Speicherstadt), a World Heritage Site, the Great Concert Hall (Elbphilharmonie), and the city hall (Rathaus). To gather even more cultural experiences, we visited the Museum of Ethnology, the Winter Dom, and the Christmas Market.

By touring the university campus and trying the canteen, we could partly experience what it is like to be a student at the University of Hamburg. As it was my first time in Germany, I found every cultural difference interesting. I even had the chance to use my beginner German knowledge a few times.

The Road Trip helped me view the role of students in EUGLOH from a wider perspective and gave me the opportunity to connect with the students of other alliances and learn from their existing practices.



Florabelle and I also had the chance to share what we are doing in our LSB. We have found this road trip very inspiring and will return to Szeged with new ideas that we hope to put into practice.”
