Idea challenge: Biomedical engineering for global health

28-30 November 2023 - Novi Sad - Final event

Within the EUGLOH Alliance WP3, the University of Novi Sad hosted the event „Idea challenge: Biomedical engineering for global health” which gathered students from UNS and two other EUGLOH partner universities – Universidade do Porto (Portugal) and University of Szeged (Hungary). The final part of the event took place from 28th to 30th November 2023 in Novi Sad when students presented their innovative ideas in the field of biomedical engineering for global health.

After the creation of the teams, students had the chance to improve their innovative idea thanks to two preparation webinars and two mentoring sessions. These online activities, held during September and October, were followed by the three-day onsite programme at the University of Novi Sad, where they had the opportunity to broaden their knowledge through practical presentations of ongoing biomedical engineering projects, as well as through workshops which covered topics such as proposal writing (Horizon), moving-up on TRL scale, and understanding a business part of an innovation. On the third day of their stay at the University of Novi Sad, the teams presented their innovative ideas in front of an expert jury.

After evaluating all presented innovative ideas, the jury announced that the winner is the team from the University of Szeged (Hungary). The winning idea „Smart sticker for oral cancer” was proposed by the team members: Nominzul Altankhuyag, Ikhwan Yuda Kusuma, Swagata Chakraborty, and Chiminvang Yiaxouavang.

The EUGLOH Idea Challenge organized by the University of Novi Sad offered students a chance to gain deeper knowledge and understanding about the development path from idea to innovation, proposal writing techniques for an innovation project, its effective presentation, and scientific and market development.



Apart from the official programme, the participants of the EUGLOH Idea Challenge also enjoyed taking part in social events, gatherings and activities during their free time, organized by the University of Novi Sad EUGLOH student team.

MaPLaS+S Entrepreneurial Skills and Self-Audit Pitching Training

21-30 November 2023 - MaPLaS+S

Between the **21-30 November 2023**, the University of Szeged hosted a EUGLOH WP4 comprehensive online training event: **MaPLaS+S Entrepreneurial Skills and Self-Audit Pitching Training**.

☛ MaPLaS+S is designed to enhance entrepreneurial skills among students and was organized the fourth time.

☛ The training emphasized the multifaceted aspects entrepreneurs need to consider, beyond just having a good idea. As a playfully end of the course, on the last day students took part in a so-called 'self-audit pitching competition', where future entrepreneurs could try themselves by demonstrating what they've learnt.

☛ Even though the host of the training activity was the University of Szeged, lecturers also came from the University of Lund and University of Porto.



University of Szeged for Global Health

25-27 October 2023

Between 25th and 27th October, EUGLOHRIA held a Back-to-Back event in Porto incorporating a Workshop on Developing guidelines for Future Pandemics, a Conference on Transnational Perspectives in Sharing Infrastructures in Global Health, and a European Symposium Innovation in Global Health. The participants of all three parts discussed the harmonization of their research projects, discovered different university structures, and shared good practices regarding business relations.

The University of Szeged was represented by Prof. Dr. Zoltán Kónya, Vice-Rector for Scientific Affairs and Innovation and Professional supervisor of the Centre of Excellence for Interdisciplinary Research, Development and Innovation (IKIKK), Prof. Dr. Ildikó Csóka, Director-General for Strategic Development, the Operations supervisor of IKIKK, Dr. Livia Berkecz-Kovács, the Operations manager of the Cluster of Life Sciences, Anikó Bucsiné Pados Project manager and WP3 coordinator, Dr. Krisztina Körmendiné Buzás, Head of the Department of Immunology at Albert Szent-Györgyi Medical School, Dr. Judit Danis Adjunct Professor, and Mária Harmati PhD student.

During the event, WP leaders presented joint results achieved in the framework of the project, then attended roundtable discussions on the topic and the sustainability of research and development.

The event supported pilot projects as well: the goal is to launch new, joint researches using joint infrastructure. The PRINS and EVIND projects are such joint projects executed by the Université Paris-Saclay and the University of Szeged together. These pilot projects are initiatives supported with a more limited financial support that are meant to pave the way for long-term cooperations.

Beside the workshops, the representatives of the University of Szeged had fruitful exchanges and strengthened ties with others members of the Alliance, lecturers, local authorities, and third-parties from the partners' livid ecosystems.
