

- Type of letter, font and size: We recommend using the following font and font size: Type of font: Arial - Title: At least 36 points. - Headings: 30 points or more. - Text: At least 24 points.
- · Type of exhibition: Physical poster

Please note that the application deadline is 6 June 2024.

The workshop on Good Scientific Practice provides information on key facts and concepts. It addresses general questions about the **specificity of scientific work, the importance of values and norms.** Questionable behaviour and conflicts of interest are addressed. Dilemmas are presented on the different topics and decision options are discussed in group discussions to encourage critical thinking and responsible decision making. Various aspects of Open Science round off the workshop.

Farticipants of the in-person workshop at LMU are invited to attend the Responsible Research event on Thursday 25 July 2024, also in-person, at the Life Sciences Campus in Munich Martinsried / Planegg.

ESA24 Memories

Read the EUGLOH story of Márcio dos Santos de Sousa, participant of the European Students Assembly (ESA204)

"From April 10th to 12th, I had the incredible opportunity to visit the European Union **Parliament** in Strasbourg and participate in the third edition of the European Students Assembly (ESA24) alongside more than 250 students from universities across Europe. In the two months leading up to the event, we engaged in regular online meetings and workshops to delve into policy drafting and develop our own proposals. Although the assembly has concluded, the impact of this experience will undoubtedly last a lifetime.



I'm Márcio dos Santos de Sousa, a second-year Master's student in International Relations at the University of Szeged in Hungary. As a Brazilian, the opportunity to study on a different continent, immerse myself in a new culture, and participate in a remarkable project like ESA has been truly life-changing.

The experience at ESA24 was centered around commitment, optimism, and the exchange of ideas. Although we didn't have the chance to meet everyone, we were divided into eleven groups based on our panels. I was part of Panel 4, focused on shaping a better future for the EU. Our goal was to develop strategies that would ensure dignified treatment of migrants from outside the Union.

Sharing stories with other students, hearing their experiences, achievements, failures, expectations, and fears made this entire experience more human, compelling, and special. We spent time discussing our alliances, debating politics, dreaming of future professional opportunities, and admiring the European Parliament building—I often expressed how delighted I would be to work in such a place. While we agreed and disagreed on various policy proposals, we managed to accomplish our goals. It was incredibly rewarding to see all eight of our proposals pass during the plenary session, which invoked a sense of responsibility and democracy in action while establishing and voting on the EU's priorities.

Outside of our work sessions, we enjoyed evenings together, chatting as much as we could, exploring the city, laughing, and having fun. We learned about the European Union's role in the world and felt a collective urgency to do more for the future of our generation and the ones to come.

This opportunity was truly special and unique. I am immensely grateful to my alliance, EUGLOH, for allowing me to be part of this enriching environment. While I'm uncertain about what the future holds, I am confident that I will leverage the skills I acquired during this experience to make the most of it."
