📍 This semester started strong, as University of Szeged colleague participated in a workshop held at the **University of Hamburg** to co-create innovation connected to global health.

👉 “Recently, I had the opportunity to participate in a workshop called "Co-Creating Innovation", which focused on the topic of Global Health. During the program, BSc, MSc students, PhD students and young researchers **worked together in teams of 5-8 people**, where we identified global health problems and developed innovative product ideas to solve them. At the end of the workshop, our teams prepared **marketable presentations**, during which we presented our developments taking into account business and competitiveness aspects. The special value of the event was that the **participants came from different professional backgrounds**, which greatly contributed to the creative teamwork. With the help of design thinking, pitch talk and co-creative work mini-trainings, we have learned new skills that are essential in the world of startups. I definitely recommend the workshop to those who want to try themselves outside the academic world and **gain a deeper insight into how to turn an idea into a marketable product.**”

The Make Our Planet Great Again (MOPGA) call for applications is intended to welcome at least 60 early career researchers wishing to carry out their research in France. The program is funded by the French Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs, in collaboration with the French Ministry for Higher Education and Research, and implemented by Campus France.

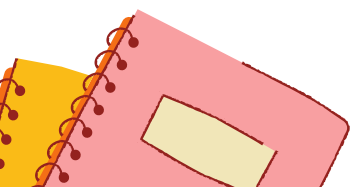
A way to connect our researchers and start cooperation in the following topics:

- Earth systems
- Climate change and sustainability
- Energy transition
- Societal challenges of environmental issues
- Human, animal and ecosystem health as part as a "One Health" approach.

WHO MAY APPLY?

- Foreign researchers holding a doctoral degree for less than 5 years
- No nationality restrictions (except France)
- 60 fellowships will be awarded for a 12-month period from September 2025
- This fellowship includes the following benefits :
- Monthly allowance of 2,500 euros
- Moving allowance of 500 euros
- Health Insurance plan covering civil liability and repatriation assistance until the MOPGA Fellow's registration to the French Social Security Scheme
- Complementary Health Insurance plan covering civil liability and repatriation assistance once the Social Security registration process is effective.

📌 Cooperate with the University of Alcalá

A teacher from the University of Alcalá is looking for academic partners to submit a short course proposal in EUGLOH.

Field: economics / political science / decision making/game theory/mathematics

Description: This course provides an in-depth exploration of Game Theory, a mathematical framework for analyzing strategic interactions among rational decision-makers. The course covers key concepts such as Nash equilibrium, dominant strategies, mixed strategies, and extensive-form games, as well as applications to economic, political, and social contexts. Additionally, it addresses the fundamentals of decision theory, examining how individuals and organizations make choices under conditions of risk and uncertainty.

Students will develop analytical skills to model and solve competitive and cooperative scenarios, gaining insights into the behavior of firms, markets, governments, and individuals. By the end of the course, participants will be able to apply game-theoretic models to real-world situations, enhancing their understanding of strategic decision-making in various fields.

The course is designed for individuals with an interest in economics, political science, business strategy, and related disciplines. Prior knowledge of basic mathematics and probability theory is recommended.
