Certificate of Advanced Studies in Global Health



Next round is open now!

Dear Professors, Dear Teachers,

The EUGLOH Certificate of Advanced Studies in Global Health programme addresses the complex interrelationships between health, the environment and society, which cannot be researched solely on a subject-specific basis but require trans- and interdisciplinary approaches. It offers highly motivated students the opportunity to engage in dialogue with different disciplines in the global health sector during their studies, preparing them for careers in study, research and practice to improve health and achieve health equity for all people worldwide.

The qualification consisting of at least 17 ECTS-credits over the course of two **semesters**, is completed alongside the main degree subject. It allows students to explore beyond the scope of their current disciplines and gain a broader perspective, increasing their employability in the future.

- Target Group: Master students, PhD students or students in their 7th semester or higher in undergraduate programmes longer than 6 semesters (such as medical school, law, etc.).
- Number of places: 30
- This year's essay topic is: What are the implications of mass vaccinations? Please argue from a multidisciplinary perspective and include a personal opinion.

Clinical Legal Education 👰

Professor of University of Alcalá seeking partnership

<u>Miguel Ángel Ramiro</u>, a professor at the **University of Alcalá, is seeking partners** within the EUGLOH alliance to collaborate on a course proposal titled "Clinical Legal Education: The Rights of People Living with HIV."

- This proposal aims to find partners in the EUGLOH alliance who share the same interests in **legal education innovation**, **knowledge transfer and applied research in the field of human rights**.
- These three tasks would be channeled through clinical legal education focused on the legal literacy of people with a disability or chronic illness, especially HIV, and through research on the legal determinants of health that affect them.

This proposal can be articulated as a course that can be taught in any of the universities that make up the EUGLOH alliance if there is no legal clinic in the Faculty of Law or as a space for reflection in which different legal clinics can share knowledge about legal education, knowledge transfer and applied research.

The Make Our Planet Great Again (MOPGA) call for applications is intended to welcome at least 60 early career researchers wishing to carry out their research in France. The program is funded by the French Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs, in collaboration with the French Ministry for Higher Education and Research, and implemented by Campus France.

A way to connect our researchers and start cooperation in the following topics:

- · Earth systems
- · Climate change and sustainability
- Energy transition
- Societal challenges of environmental issues
- Human, animal and ecosystem health as part as a "One Health" approach.

WHO MAY APPLY?

- Foreign researchers holding a doctoral degree for less than 5 years
- No nationality restrictions (except France)
- 60 fellowships will be awarded for a 12-month period from September 2025
- This fellowship includes the following benefits:
- Monthly allowance of 2,500 euros
- Moving allowance of 500 euros
- Health Insurance plan covering civil liability and repatriation assistance until the MOPGA Fellow's registration to the French Social Security Scheme
- Complementary Health Insurance plan covering civil liability and repatriation assistance once the Social Security registration process is effective.
