Transversal meeting of WP5 and WP8 in Paris

Let's see what our colleagues were up to!

- Colleagues represented the University of Szeged in Paris!
- The main elements that were discussed are the application of the operational goals and specific goals of WP5. These goals should always be applied and considered in every project aspect (e.g. EUGLOH Hub, trainings and courses, and conferences). The creation of EUGLOH hub and the collaboration between WP5 and WP8 representatives for a more fruitful work. For WP8, the main focus was on reporting, main messages and joint communication messages.
- The outcome of the event was fruitful despite of the limited time. There are some topics that could have given more focused and time but nonetheless the schedule was followed and was given a substantial attention.

¶ "I think it is really important for us at this point to discuss external relations and the approach for this, for the alliance. Mhen developing the external partnerships of the alliance, we must consider the already existing professional network of each member university, and their experience and expertise within that particular environment. Some types of partnerships where the cooperation will remain relatively low profile, the role of individual member universities in approaching new partners, in discussions and arrangements, and in the management of that particular partnership will be invaluable. This independence will also come with some level accountability for the productivity of that partnership. More structural high profile partnerships will have to be managed on the alliance level. These differences between different partnership types must be clearly defined and properly managed in order to successfully extend the network of the alliance." - Zsolt Bereczki, WP7 Academic Lead for USZ

Call for Funds open at WP2 task group of Joint Learning Pathways

WHAT INITIATIVES CAN BE SUPPORTED?

Please, note that signatures are needed from the heads of departments (or dean, vice rector or other authorised level) at all the institutions involved, as well as the signatures from the participating teachers.

SELECTION, MONITORING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROJECTS

Applications will be carefully reviewed and the results of the call will be communicated in April 2025. A brief progress report (1 page) on the state of all seed-funded projects is requested four months after they have been selected. A final report is required at the completion of the project about its implementation, the challenges faced during the co-creation process, and the next actions that will be taken.

The courses, COILs and programmes developed with the EUGLOH funding do not have to start running during the current year.

Instructions about how the funding can be used and the financial reporting will be provided by the respective institutions involved in the approved proposals.

HOW TO FIND TEACHERS FOR COLLABORATION

Make use of the <u>EUGLOH Visiting Guest Lecturer Programme</u> to find teachers at the other EUGLOH partner universities to collaborate with.
