#### **Application Requirements in General**

• Business Administration and Management BSc: high school degree, English language certificate (minimum B1), valid passport (for non EU citizens). Unless the candidate has a valid SAT-score in mathematics above a certain level and an acceptable English certificate (IELTS, TOEFL, etc.) he/she has to sit for an entrance exam

- International Economy and Business MSc: BSc degree in a field related to economics (transcript of records shall be provided for review), English language certificate (minimum B2), valid passport (for non EU citizens). All eligible candidates have to take an oral entrance exam in English either personally in Szeged or via Skype costing 200 EUR.
- PhD in Economics: MSc degree in a related field to economics (transcript of records shall be provided for review), research topic and plan, English language certificate, valid passport (for non EU citizens). All eligible candidates have to take an oral entrance exam in English either personally in Szeged or via Skype.
