- For the Performance (BA) programme: high school diploma, a demonstrated proficiency in English (B1/Intermediate) and online entrance exam
- For the Classical Musical Instrumental Performance (MA) and Classical Singing (MA) program: BA degree in performance/ musicology, a demonstrated proficiency in English (B1/Intermediate), and online entrance exam.
