

Professor Hans Reinauer was born in 1933 in B \acute{a} tasz \acute{e} k, Hungary. His family was deported to Germany in 1947. He studied medicine in Bonn, Freiburg and D \ddot{u} sseldorf. He received MD degree in 1959, habilitation in 1968. In 1971 he became the director of the Diabetes Research Institute at the Heinrich Heine University D \ddot{u} sseldorf and in 1973 the Head of the Department of Clinical Biochemistry at the same Institution.

Professor Reinauer is a recognized leading person in the standardization and quality control of clinical biochemistry analytics worldwide. He developed a close collaboration with the Central Laboratory of Clinical Chemistry and the Department of Biochemistry over the past decades. He provided valuable support in establishing and operating QualiCont, the external quality control organization in Hungary. He participated in Pathobiochemistry and Medical Analytics education of several german classes at our university. He supervised the thesis work of several PhD students within the Doctoral School of Multidisciplinary Medical Sciences.
