Privacy Policy on data processing related to the University of Szeged Virtual Open Day Dedicated to Prospective International Students 2019.

The University of Szeged Virtual Open Day Dedicated to Prospective International Students 2019 is an online event to be conducted on the 24<sup>th</sup> April 2019, from 09:00-10:30 (CET). The online platform on which the event can be accessed is '[Study in Szeged](#)' Facebook page. The event is open for public and anyone with a Facebook profile can join the event.

The Moderator moderates the event, receiving questions from Participants joining the event. A conversation with students/former students (Contributors) of the University of Szeged will be recorded during the online streaming.

The language of the event is English.

### 2. Legal Background

We inform you that the University of Szeged as data controller deals with all personal data in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC and Act 112 of 2011 on the Right of Informational Self-Determination and on Freedom of Information.

## 4. Data Processing During the Event

The following data processing takes place during the University of Szeged Virtual Open Day Dedicated to Prospective International Students 2019 – 1. Facebook profile and its public data, 2. individual recordings of the Contributors and of the Moderator

### 4.1. Data processing of the Participants

Facebook profiles of Participants joining and leaving the event, as well as participants asking direct questions from the Moderator during the event will be addressed under the name indicated on 'First name' section of their Facebook profile and their country of origin if accessible. Data processing is based on voluntary consent. Facebook profiles and its public data of the participants will not be visible for other individuals joining the event. Such data will only be visible for the Moderator on a control monitor, hidden from the audience and the Participants and the Contributors.

Participants are invited to join the event on the abovementioned date. The event is open for public and can be joined by anyone with a registered Facebook profile, without having to follow the Facebook page of 'Study in Szeged'. In the course of the online streaming, Participants are allowed to ask their questions with the use of their Facebook profiles, thus providing their Facebook profile and related data in the abovementioned manner. Once the online streaming has ended, the recording remains available on 'Study in Szeged' Facebook page and will be deleted within 365 days following the online streaming.

### 4.2. Online Streaming

We inform you that a recording of the online streaming will be proceeded. Data processing during the event is based on voluntary consent.

In the course of the online streaming and its recording, likeness and/or voice of SZTE employees are recorded based on the legitimate interest of the University of Szeged and of students and former students (Contributors) are recorded based on voluntary consent.

According to Section 2:48 Article (2) of Act 5 of 2013 on the Civil Code, the consent of the relevant person is not required for recording his/her likeness or voice, and for the use of such recording if made of a crowd or in a public event. However, previous information should be given in these cases, so we fulfill the preliminary notification obligation to inform data subjects through this Privacy Policy, and through information provided at the event stating: "We would like to inform you that photos will be taken during this event".

As the University of Szeged is dedicated to the protection and safety of all kinds of personal data, and the respect of privacy, we inform you that we use the recording of the online streaming and in a public event to promote the University of Szeged among prospective students and for marketing purposes the online and offline channels of the University of Szeged.

According to Section 2:48 Article (2) of Act 5 of 2013 on the Civil Code, the consent of the students/former students participating the online stream is not required for recording his/her likeness or voice, and for the use of such recording if made of a crowd or in a public event. In order to identify the Contributors we record their first and surname, mother's maiden name to file their voluntary consent.

We inform you that data subjects can withdraw the consent to the processing of their personal data at any time. Voluntary consent can be withdrawn with the following conditions: once the participant of the online streaming decides to withdraw their voluntary consent, complaints can be filed within 14 days following the online streaming. The University of Szeged guarantees the right for erasure with the use of the technology at disposal in a timely manner. Withdrawals of the voluntary consent filed after 14 days following the online streaming will be reviewed based on the University's legitimate interest.

## 5. Transmitting Data

In the course of the online streaming of the University of Szeged Virtual Open Day Dedicated to Prospective International Students 2019, there is no action taken in transmitting data neither inland nor abroad. The recording of the online streaming will be published on 'Study in Szeged' Facebook page and will be removed within 365 days after the online streaming. Your data will be processed by the Data Processor precised in Section 1 and employees assigned by the manager of the abovementioned body with the purpose, legal basis and data storage period.

## 6. Data Processing from Third Parties

We are not processing personal data from third parties. Your personal data will be provided based on your voluntary consent and not from other sources.

## 7. Automated decision-making

No automated decision-making happens in the course of the online streaming.

## 8. Data Subject Rights

We inform you about your rights in connection with the University of Szeged Virtual Open Day Dedicated to Prospective International Students 2019:

1. right to information – you have the right to ask for information on the processing of your personal data.
2. right of access by the data subject – you have access to your personal data we process.
3. right to rectification – should you find inaccuracies in your personal data processed by us, you have the right to ask for rectification.
4. right to erasure – if there is no other legal basis for data processing, you can ask for the erasure of your personal data.
5. right to object – you have the right to object against data processing based on legitimate interest at any time.
6. right to restriction of processing – you have the right to ask for the restriction of the processing of your personal data, for example after you find inaccuracies in your personal

data, you can ask for restriction of processing while the University of Szeged is checking the data.

7. right to data portability – in automated data processing, if data processing is based on voluntary consent, and you need your personal data, your personal data processed by us is given to you.

8. right to legal remedy – every data subject has the right to legal remedy in case of an infringement
