2. Legal Background of our Privacy Policy

We inform you that the University of Szeged as data controller deals with all personal data in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC and Act 112 of 2011 on the Right of Informational Self-Determination and on Freedom of Information.

5. Transmitting Data

Your data will be processed by the Data Processor precised in Section 1 and employees assigned by the manager of the abovementioned body with the purpose, legal basis and data storage period indicated in section 4.

6. Data Processing from Third Parties

We are not processing personal data from third parties. Your personal data will be provided based on your voluntary consent and not from other sources.

7. Automated decision-making

No automated decision-making happens in the course of the online streaming.

8. Data Subject Rights

We inform you about your rights in connection with the SZTE+ Program:

1. right to information – you have the right to ask for information on the processing of your personal data.
2. right of access by the data subject – you have access to your personal data we process.
3. right to rectification – should you find inaccuracies in your personal data processed by us, you have the right to ask for rectification.
4. right to erasure – if there is no other legal basis for data processing, you can ask for the erasure of your personal data.
5. right to object – you have the right to object against data processing based on legitimate interest at any time.
6. right to restriction of processing – you have the right to ask for the restriction of the processing of your personal data, for example after you find inaccuracies in your personal data, you can ask for restriction of processing while the University of Szeged is checking the data.
7. right to data portability – in automated data processing, if data processing is based on voluntary consent, and you need your personal data, your personal data processed by us is given to you.
8. right to legal remedy – every data subject has the right to legal remedy in case of an infringement
