Dear Students,

We would like to provide you with some information about the voluntary work:

- Doing voluntary work is the only way at the moment to continue your 6th year clinical rotations. The days/weeks during which you do voluntary work will form part of your 6th year practices. The students not willing to do voluntary work must wait until it is possible again to go back to the clinics/hospitals and do the practices then. Those students will most probably be able to take their state board examinations in the August or November exam period.
- Voluntary work can be done both in and outside Szeged. A contract will have to be signed by the hospital and the student before starting the voluntary work. It will be for a definite period of time but can be renewed.
- It is the Clinical Center of the University that will decide about which volunteer will go to which clinic taking into consideration the students' original practice plans. However, volunteers can be moved to another clinic if their help is more desired there if/when the epidemic situation deteriorates.
- It is necessary to hold a valid medical fitness certificate to do voluntary work. In case it has already expired you must contact the occupational doctor to renew it.
- Volunteers will be provided with appropriate protective gear.
