# LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

MIR is fully taught in English.

#### Criteria for admission:

- IELTS 6.5 or interchangeable TOEFL 79-93 score interval (equivalent to CEFR B1-C2 level) OR
- Degree attesting graduation from a fully-English-taught BA program (provides exemption from the above requirements).

Language skills will be verified on the occasion of an Admission Interview through VOIP, or in person if the applicant has access to the Faculty.

Admission Interviews are generally conducted from the first week of July for each Academic Year.

# DEGREES ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION

- Undergraduate Degree in Law, BA in International Relations, BA in International Studies (for international students); any degrees that qualify under the relevant Hungarian rules; please consult: http://www.felvi.hu
- Those applicants who do not hold BA degree in International Relations, will need to provide their academic transcript for review to the Admission Committee to check compliance with necessary entry credits (30 ECTS) based on Hungarian regulations.

#### DR. ANITA PELLE




Associate Professor at the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration, Jean Monnet Chair, Program Director of the English-language Master in International Economy and Business
