




To apply, please visit Reimagine-Education.com, and click on the red 'Apply Now' button.






Whilst you are able to create various entries, please ensure that you give each a different project title, to help both you and the organising committee distinguish between submissions.




When adding the contact information for your project, please ensure that you put the name and contact information for the individual that you trust to relay the appropriate information, or opportunities to the team at large. This preferably is someone directly involved in the project.



When completing your Project Details, please bear in mind that this will be what is seen by the judges, and should be presented with that intention.




When you are filling out your institution or organisation name, please ensure that the full name is given, particularly if you are applying on behalf of a department or school within a greater institution. Refrain from the use of unspecified acronyms, as our records, and subsequent publications including the awards themselves, will be based off this information you provide.




Please take your time with compiling your project synopsis, since even if you have a wonderful project, this is the main basis that the judges have to know about what you do. Remember that in 2015 you are now able to log back in to finalise applications, so make sure you plan accordingly to facilitate submission of the best portrayal of your project.
