Call for Abstracts: 'Showcasing Undergraduate Paediatric Research' Poster Conference As part of the National Medical Student Paediatric Conference (NMSPC) 2015

As part of the NMSPC we will be holding a poster competition, 'Showcasing Undergraduate Paediatric Research'. All delegates are invited to submit a poster on a paediatric-related topic.

The poster competition is primarily to present research in paediatric medicine or surgery, however we are aware that this may not be possible for all medical students, therefore will also be accepting submissions of all paediatric-related posters (including case studies, electives, novel research or SSC/SSMs).

We require all posters to have an element of a literature review. Each poster must be presented by one student only (the presenter must be the first author and thus have a ticket for the NMSPC) however other authors may be acknowledged. Please ensure that you have permission from all authors before submission.

Poster size must be A1 (standard A sizing) but there are no restrictions on font size and design layout. Delegates must print their own posters and bring them to the conference. Posters must include references, in the form of Vancouver or Harvard.

In order to be invited to bring your poster, please email your details and poster abstract to bsmspaedsoc@gmail.com by Wednesday 8th April 2015 23:59. Please ensure that you have bought your NMSPC ticket before submitting an abstract. We will confirm by email that we have received your submission. The topic of the poster cannot be changed once the deadline has been reached.

The preliminary submission should include:

- The title of the poster
- Author and contact email address.
- Medical School
- An abstract that provides an overview of your poster and is no longer than 300 words in length

At the Poster Conference Posters will be displayed on the Saturday of the Conference. A judging panel will view the posters, aided with the abstract that will introduce them to the content of your poster. Finalists will then be selected to present their posters in front of the judging panel on the Sunday. All finalists that have presented their poster will be issued with a certificate to acknowledge their achievement. Prizes will be confirmed shortly.
