

Call for young researchers – free registration opportunity for NanoPlastHub 2026

The organisers of NanoPlastHub 2026 are committed to supporting the next generation of scientists and encouraging active participation in research.

We are pleased to announce a call for applications, offering free conference participation to MSc and PhD students, as well as postdoctoral researchers (within seven years of obtaining their PhD) who present their research at the event.

Successful applicants will have the opportunity to present their research in an oral or poster session and will be exempt from the conference registration fee.

Application requirements:

- Full name and academic status (MSc/PhD student or postdoctoral researcher for up to seven years after completing a PhD).
- Provisional title of the presentation.
- Short summary of the research (preliminary version, not the final abstract; up to approx. 1500 characters).
- Confirmed willingness to present at the conference (please, indicate your preference).

Topic focus:

The conference will focus on sub-micron plastic contaminants (nanoplastics) and related topics. We particularly welcome submissions that address research on nanoplastics or microplastics, especially with regard to their occurrence, behaviour, interactions with co-pollutants, environmental and biological impact, detection and characterisation, remediation or modelling.

Applications will be reviewed by the Organizing Committee and successful applicants will be notified via email.
