Concerning the Processing of Personal Data for the JATE Award Nomination and Evaluation Procedure

This Data Processing Notice provides information on how your personal data is used and protected in connection with the nomination and evaluation procedure for the JATE Award, in accordance with the provisions of the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

About the JATE Award

Professor Katalin Karikó, a former student of József Attila University (JATE) – one of the legal predecessors of the University of Szeged (SZTE) – and currently a professor at SZTE, donated the replica of her 2023 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine, along with the accompanying monetary award of over \$500,000, to her alma mater. Using the donated funds, Professor Katalin Karikó and the University of Szeged have established the **JATE Award**.

The award is presented annually at the University of Szeged during the ceremony held on the occasion of University Day (November 11). It may be granted to three individuals:

- a current student of the University of Szeged (SZTE),
- a current instructor of the University of Szeged (SZTE), and
- a former student or former instructor of SZTE or its legal predecessor (JATE).

In each of the three categories, the JATE Award includes the following:

- a unique work of art and a presentation case;
- a certificate of honor; and
- a monetary prize.

6. Do we collect personal data from other sources?

We only obtain personal data from the nominator.

7. Does data processing involve automated decision-making?

Data processing for the JATE Award Nomination and Evaluation Procedure does not involve any automated decision-making processes.

8. What are the legal implications for you if you choose not to provide the requested data?

Please note that the legal basis for data processing for the JATE Award Nomination and Evaluation Procedure is neither the fulfillment of a legal obligation (GDPR 6(1)(c)) nor a contractual requirement (GDPR 6(1)(b)).

Generally, failure to provide the requested data, as outlined in this Data Processing Notice, will not result in any disadvantages for you. However, please be informed that without nominators providing the required information, nominees will not be eligible to receive the JATE Award.

9. What legitimate interests do we have in processing the data?

The data processing activities outlined herein are not based on legitimate interests. Instead, our data processing is carried out based on other legal grounds.

10. What rights do you have in connection with data processing?

You have the following rights in connection with the processing of your data:

1. Right to be informed: You may request information about how your personal data is being processed. This right is ensured through the creation and distribution of this Data Processing Notice.
2. Right of access: You are entitled to obtain a copy of the personal data we hold in relation to you, along with details on how this data is being processed.
3. Right to rectification: If you become aware of any inaccuracies in your personal data, you have the right to request the necessary corrections.
4. Right to object: For reasons related to your specific situation, you have the right to object – at any time – to the processing of your personal data when the processing is based on public interest. In such cases, the data controller will cease processing your personal data for the disputed purpose unless they can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds that override your interests, rights, and freedoms, or if the processing is necessary for asserting, exercising, or defending legal claims.

5. Right to withdraw voluntary consent: You have the right to withdraw your voluntary consent to data processing at any time. Please note that withdrawing your consent does not affect the lawfulness of any data processing conducted prior to the withdrawal.
6. Right to erasure: If the processing of your personal data is solely based on voluntary consent and no other legal grounds apply, you have the right to request the deletion of your data.
7. Right to restriction of processing: You may request that we limit or restrict the processing of your personal data, for instance, if you contest the accuracy of the data – and restriction is to be applied until the data is verified by the data controller – or if restriction is necessary in connection with the exercise or defense of legal claims.
8. Right to remedies: In the event of a violation of your rights, you are entitled to seek appropriate legal remedy.
