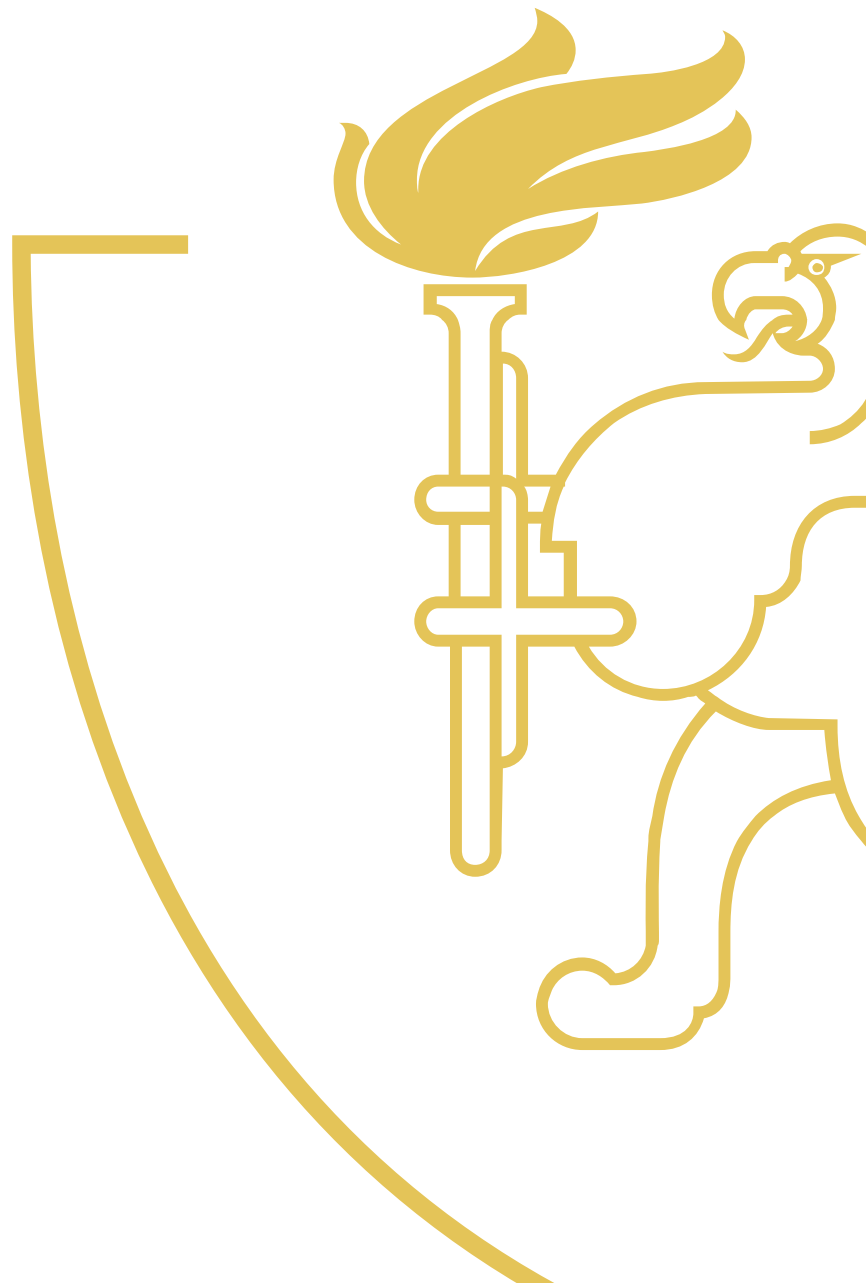


Smart Online Education

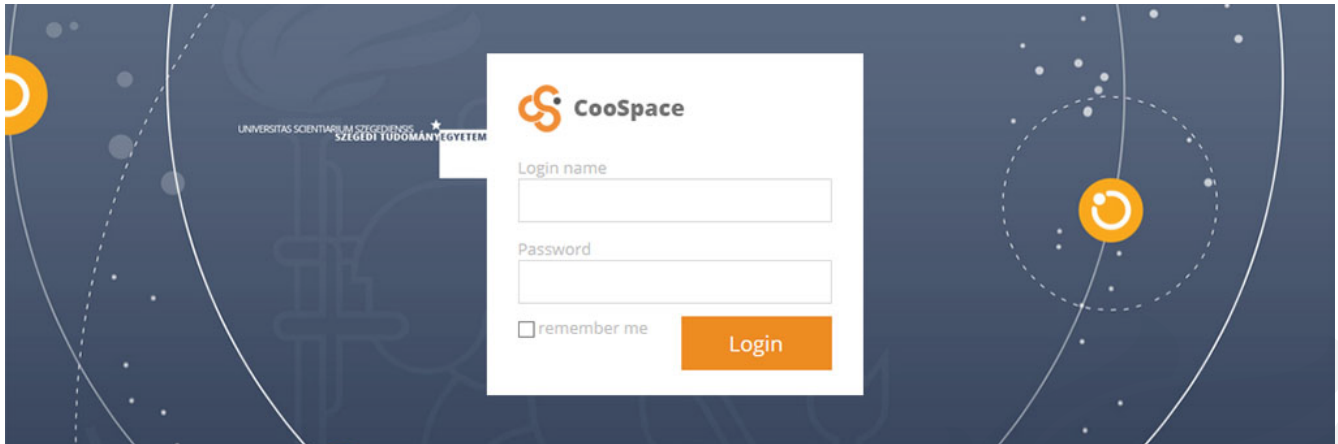

1. Coospace – the official source

The primary and official scene of the extraordinary online education continues to be **CooSpace**, please get information on courses from there:



- every course has a CooSpace scene
- the scenes of CooSpace connect the students and the teachers of the given course
- entrance to CooSpace is via Neptun or former ETR login

If you do not yet have information on course completion as part of the extraordinary online education, please contact the course instructor without delay.

Information from the University of Szeged Klebelsberg Library on accessing library resources for successful exam preparation:



The University of Szeged Klebelsberg Library is currently not open to visitors. Entering the premises of the library, borrowing and returning books is not possible; however, past due fees are not charged during this period of time. In view of the distance learning, **online library registration** is already possible. Students of the University of Szeged who have already registered can use online services as usual.

Coursera is the world's largest education platform where

- in 11 disciplines,
- in 19 languages,
- from 190 universities and large corporations around the world (such as Yale and IBM),
- 4,000 courses

are available free of charge to the citizens of the University of Szeged.

- In the Coursera for SZTE programme, courses may be taken or dropped any time.
- Registrants can take any number of courses.
- If a student fails an exam test, the test may be taken as many times as necessary.
