

STUDY PROGRAM OPTIONS

Full-Time Degree Programs

- Bachelor's Programs (BA/BSc): Undergraduate level, 6–8 semesters
- Master's Programs (MA/MSc): Graduate level, 2–4 semesters
- One-Tier Master's Programs: Integrated programs, 10–12 semesters
- Doctoral Programs (PhD): 8 semesters

Non-Degree Programs

- Professional and Language Preparatory Courses
- Specialization Courses: 1–2 semesters

The primary language of instruction is English, though many programs are also available in French, German, Spanish, Italian, Russian, Turkish, or Hungarian.



SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS

■ Tuition-Free Education

Scholarship holders are fully exempt from paying tuition fees.

■ Financial and Academic Support

Available for bachelor's, master's, one-tier master's, non-degree, and doctoral programs:

Contribution to accommodation costs: either a free dormitory place or a monthly allowance of HUF 40,000 (approximately EUR 100) for the entire duration of the scholarship period

THE STIPENDIUM HUNGARICUM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Stipendium Hungaricum is a prestigious scholarship program funded by the Hungarian government for international students. It provides full tuition coverage, a monthly stipend, accommodation support, and medical insurance – making it a highly attractive opportunity for students worldwide.

ELIGIBILITY

For an application to be considered valid, the applicant must be a legal adult and must turn 18 by the start of their studies, but no later than August 31, 2025. (An exception applies to applicants in the field of dance arts.) There is no upper age limit set by the program; however, applicants are advised to consult their Sending Partner for any country-specific age requirements.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications for a Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship must be submitted through the DreamApply system.

Application is free of charge, so applicants are strongly advised not to use any agencies or pay for external services.

The application deadline is typically January 15 each year, and the selection process takes approximately six months. See the timeline below for key stages.
