Albert Szent-Györgyi and Vitamin C

Albert Szent-Györgyi, Nobel laureate and former rector of the University of Szeged, was awarded the Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine in 1937 for his groundbreaking research on biological combustion processes, particularly his work on vitamin C and the catalysis of fumaric acid. A significant discovery made by Szent-Györgyi was that Szeged paprika contains significantly higher levels of hexuronic acid – now known as vitamin C – than citrus fruits. The University of Szeged is proud to carry on the scientific legacy of Albert Szent-Györgyi, honoring his profound contributions to science and the advancement of humanity.

Katalin Karikó and mRNA vaccines

Katalin Karikó, recipient of the 2023 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine, is an honorary doctor, professor, and alumna of the University of Szeged. She was awarded the Nobel Prize jointly with her research partner, Drew Weissman, “for their discoveries concerning nucleoside base modifications that enabled the development of effective mRNA vaccines against COVID-19.” Professor Karikó began studying RNA at the University of Szeged and the Szeged Biological Research Center at a time when it was widely regarded as unpromising for therapeutic use. However, her dedication over the past three decades has been instrumental in bringing mRNA vaccines to the world. Katalin Karikó’s achievements serve as a powerful testament to the crucial role of fundamental research in driving scientific progress.





Culture



Theater

The National Theater of Szeged, with its two venues, offers a diverse repertoire that includes performances by the city's internationally acclaimed contemporary ballet troupe. Szeged is also home to Hungary's largest open-air theater festival, held annually in the expansive historic square in front of the Cathedral.

Reök Palace

The Reök Palace is a striking masterpiece of Hungarian Art Nouveau architecture and serves as a leading regional art center. It regularly hosts exhibitions showcasing paintings, sculptures, and other artworks by contemporary artists and renowned masters from various periods and different parts of the world.

Móra Ferenc Museum and the Black House

The Móra Ferenc Museum is a cherished cultural landmark, hosting numerous popular exhibitions. Its diverse collections feature works from prestigious international museums and galleries, as well as pieces from private art collectors. Complementing the museum's grand main building is the Black House, a smaller exhibition space that offers a fascinating glimpse into various historical periods and artistic styles.

Belvárosi Cinema

Belvárosi Cinema, situated in the heart of Szeged, has been a cornerstone of the city's cultural life for over a century. The cinema offers a diverse range of programs, featuring a VR room, and cutting-edge 3D technology. In addition to thematic movie nights, it hosts an annual international film festival and a variety of engaging events.

Festivals

SZIN – Youth Festival of Szeged

The annual Youth Festival of Szeged (SZIN) is Hungary's longest-running music festival and a highlight of the city's cultural calendar. Festival-goers can enjoy performances by national and international artists across multiple stages, delivering an unforgettable experience in the heart of Szeged.

Szeged Wine Festival

The Szeged Wine Festival is one of Hungary's largest wine festivals, taking place annually in mid-May. Beyond the exquisite wines, the festival features a rich program of concerts, cultural events, family-friendly activities, and a vibrant market, creating an engaging atmosphere for all visitors.



ICE International Cultural Evening

The International Cultural Evening is a lively celebration of the University of Szeged's diverse international student community. Held every year, the event offers a unique platform for students from around the world to share their cultural heritage through fascinating music and dance performances.

Leisure & Pleasure



Erzsébet Park

As the largest park in Szeged, Erzsébet Park (Erzsébet Liget) features an open-air theater, a university sports field, and a beautiful church. Additionally, the park offers an outdoor gym, a tennis court, various sports facilities, and a running trail. Visitors can also savor culinary offerings at the gastronomy festivals held throughout the year.



SZTE Botanical Garden

The SZTE Botanical Garden offers a rich blend of natural beauty and educational value. One of its standout features is the Trail of Women Scientists, honoring distinguished female researchers from the University of Szeged, including Katalin Karikő. The garden's diverse attractions – such as its arboretum, rose garden, Japanese garden, lotus pond, and orchid house – embody its mission to celebrate biological diversity, inspire lifelong learning, and share knowledge with visitors of all ages.

Lapos Beach

Lapos Beach is located on the New Szeged (Újszeged) side of the Tisza River, right at the foot of the Downtown Bridge (Belvárosi Híd). The beach evokes a Mediterranean atmosphere, making it a popular spot for family outings, leisurely walks, and swimming. It is open to everyone free of charge.

Sports



Handball Team

Szeged takes great pride in its handball team, one of Hungary's most celebrated, with an impressive track record that includes the 2014 EHF Champions League victory, five Hungarian Championship titles, and seven Hungarian Cup wins. The official home of the OTP Bank – PICK Szeged Handball Team is the modern PICK Arena, a top-tier sports venue that also serves as a hub for community events. Off the court, the team is dedicated to meaningful causes, promoting Down syndrome awareness, breast cancer prevention, and youth education.



Watersports

Flowing through the heart of Szeged, the Tisza River adds to the city's charm with its scenic beauty and riverside activities such as canoeing and kayaking. In addition, Szeged caters to both recreational and competitive swimmers, as well as wellness seekers, with facilities like the Városi Sports Pool, Tiszavirág Sports Pool, Napfényfürdő Aquapolis Szeged, and the historic Anna Bath, which harnesses thermal waters for health and relaxation.

RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT, & INNOVATION

The University of Szeged is a leading center for research, development, and innovation (R&D&I) excellence. As an officially recognized research university, it boasts over 2,200 instructors and scholars actively engaged in national and international research projects. Many of these projects are carried out at the Szeged Biological Research Center, the Szent-Györgyi Albert Medical Center, and the ELI-ALPs Laser Research Center (Extreme Light Infrastructure – Attosecond Light Pulse Source). ELI-ALPs is equipped with world-class infrastructure, including the first system in the world capable of studying the interactions between light and matter at ultra-relativistic intensities.



The Hungarian Center of Excellence for Molecular Medicine (HCEMM) is dedicated to advancing research and development related to healthy ageing. Incorporated as the limited liability company HCEMM Kft., the center is managed by the University of Szeged in collaboration with the Biological Research Center in Szeged and Semmelweis University in Budapest, with the European Molecular Biology

Laboratory (EMBL) serving as a key partner. In addition to the initial EU Teaming Grant that facilitated the establishment of HCEMM, the center was granted National Laboratory status in Hungary in 2020. The center provides PhD students at the University of Szeged with opportunities to participate in specialized educational programs and collaborate internationally on research projects.






SPRING Student Apartments




