In addition to these, in some cases a motivational letter is necessary and an entrance examination or individual online interview is held. COMPASS

(Comparative Politics, Law, Administration and Social Science Studies)

This is a one-semester long, English-language certificate program focusing on law, political sciences, and international relations. Participants may choose from six specialized course pools and will earn a certificate upon completion, officially recognizing the number of ECTS credits gained. The COMPASS program also serves as an excellent stepping-stone toward full Master's or LL.M. studies at our Faculty.

MASTER IN INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS:

4-semester long, English-language program awarding Master degree, focusing on the legal, business and European aspects of international relations

MASTER EN ÉTUDES INTERNATIONALES:

4-semester long, French-language program awarding Master degree, focusing on the legal, European or African aspects of international relations

MASTER OF LAWS IN INTERNATIONAL AND EUROPEAN TRADE AND INVESTMENT LAW:

3-semester long, English-language program awarding LLM to those with a prior law degree and a certificate for others

COMPARATIVE INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY LAW (LL.M/CERTIFICATE):

2-semester long, English-language program awarding LLM to those with a prior law degree and a certificate for others

DOCTORAL PROGRAM IN LAW AND POLITICAL SCIENCES (PHD):

4-year long, English-language program awarding PhD, focusing on law, international relations or political sciences

SHORT TERM PROGRAMS

COMPASS (COMPARATIVE POLITICS, LAW, ADMINISTRATION AND SOCIAL SCIENCE STUDIES)

1-semester, English-language program awarding a certificate, with a focus on law, political science, or international relations, depending on the chosen specialization
