The agricultural training in Hódmezővásárhely has a past that dates back to more than 120 years. Agricultural higher education started in 1961, and the Faculty became a part of the University of Szeged in 2000

English language competence – intermediate level (B2 – IELTS 5.0 or equivalent and above); language exam certificate is not required but preferred.

International students are accommodated in the twin rooms of the Dormitory, which is located in the campus area. In the dormitory building, a restaurant is open at lunch time 7 days a week. All printed and online resources, as well as the services of both the agricultural library at the Faculty and SZTE Klebelsberg Library in Szeged are open for international students.
