APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must submit an online application form here: <https://apply.u-szeged.hu>, pay the requested fees and upload the necessary documents.

For MSc programs: Submitted online application form; Bachelor of Science certificate (BSc in Food Engineering, Biotechnology, Biology, Chemistry, Agriculture, Agronomy, Environmental Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Microbiology, Analytical, Organic Chemistry or Physic), a demonstrated proficiency in English (B2 level or equivalent) and a Skype interview (oral entrance examination).
