Lajos Rácz is a University Professor at the University of Szeged, Juhász Gyula Faculty of Education, Szeged, Hungary. In 1988, he obtained a Secondary School Teacher's degree in Geography and History at József Attila University, Szeged, Faculty of Science. His research area is the reconstruction of the climate-environmental changes of Modern Period Hungary based on historical sources. He is a member of the Bern Climate History School, founded by Professor Christian Pfister. He gained a Dr. Univ. degree in 1989, and his C.Sc. degree in 1995. In 2004, he received the title of Doctor of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (D.Sc.). He worked for extended periods, on research grants, in Switzerland, France, the Czech Republic, the Netherlands, and Germany. Besides teaching at the University of Szeged, he has been teaching for a long time at St. Stephen's University, Gödöllő, Eötvös Loránd University, Budapest, the Central European University, Budapest, and Pázmány Péter Catholic University, Budapest. He is a founding member of the European Society for Environmental History (2001), and the International Climate History Society (2012). He is a member of the editorial board of the scientific journals Belvedere Meridionale (Szeged, Hungary), Global Environment (Cambridge, UK) and Economic- and Ecohistory (Zagreb, Serbia).
